



## L-Book and e-Book Download and Install Instructions

All files are DRM free, (Digital Rights Management encryption free)

When the download zip file is unzipped, the following are the file name format type codes, so you know which eBook file is for which reader:

Example: Jae-Backwrds\_**mo**.prc

**\_pr** = eReader

**\_mo** = Mobipocket / Amazon Kindle

**\_pdf** = Adobe Digital Edition and Reader and any reader that recognizes the pdf format.

**\_ep** = ePub format = Sony, Nook, iPad, iPhone, Adobe digital Edition, KoBo devices and most all Dedicated eReader devices.

Before you can view any eBook you must have the corresponding electronic reader app installed to match the eBook format you purchased. See below for links to the electronic reader apps. L-Book Audios use the mp3 players already installed on your system or devices. Kindle, Sony and any dedicated reader have the reader app already installed in the device. See below on how to transfer MobiPocket eBook to a Kindle.

1. Click on the ordered eBook or L-Book Download link. All files are in zip format. Download links are located, in your email order receipt and in your email download install instructions besides the original download button on the web site receipt.
2. When you click on the link a file download window will popup and ask to "run", "save" and "cancel". Click the save button. Remember where you saved the file.
3. Locate the file you downloaded using the Windows Explorer and double-click the file.
4. The unzip window will appear. Use the browse button and highlight the folder to where the files will be unzipped or extracted. The recommended folder is

C:\My Documents\ Windows XP

C:\Users\Login\_Name\ Vista

Mac in your user folder

### Unzipped folder structure; unzip will create or populate if already created.

e-Book folder = *L-Book\Author\_Name\ebook-file*

L-Book folder = *L-Book\Author\_Name\Book\_Title\tracks\_mp3*

Library folder = *L-Book\L-Book\_Library\Library\_Cards, Maps, Graphics*

All L-Book Library Cards are in this folder, so at any time you can see what books you have purchased from L-Book.com. Set this folder for thumbnail view. Each library card has a picture of the book cover, back cover summary. Any maps or graphics that are imbedded into the eBooks are also saved in the L-Book Library. All cards, maps, graphics and book covers are in jpg format.

Example eBook zip extract location: *My Documents\L-Book\Jae\Jae-Holiday\_i4.pdb*  
Example L-Book zip extract location: *My Documents\L-Book\Jae\Backwards\01-Jae-Backwards\_lb.mp3*

### Troubleshooting:

If you should get an error when you double click the L-Book Audio zip file, the file got interrupted or corrupted during the download. This also includes if unzipped, you have missing or corrupted tracks. Delete the L-Book files you did download. Try to download one more time, if your download is getting interrupted, or ending up with corrupted files as second time, please email [support@L-Book.com](mailto:support@L-Book.com) with the problem you are having and include your Invoice number.

We will set you up with our alternate download system were the sound files are broken down into multiple files and are much smaller. This is also for persons who have modems or have a daily quota on the megabytes allowed to download. One can pace the file down loads to match their internet connection restrictions.

### e-Books

The electronic reader app must be installed on your system or device.

eReader devices like Kindle, Nook already have the app installed. To read Amazon Kindles eBooks on PC, MAC, iPad, iPhone, Blackberry and Android, download the free app from Amazon Kindle or if using the Barnes and Noble's eBooks they also have free apps for all the devices state above

If you do not have the e-Book reader app installed for your computer and / or mobile device, go to the following link for the e-Book reader and follow the reader's instructions to download and install.

**eReader™** - eBook file name will have **\_pr.pdb** as part of the name.

## L-Books - Audio

Add L-Book to your favorite sound Media Player and make a playlist for the book with all tracks for easier listening, same as adding a Music Album. Book cover will display if set to display, in all Media Players. There are instructions below on how to add an L-Book to the media player of your choice.

**NOTE:** Make sure your Media Players options are set:

--- **Shuffle Play** is **OFF**, Must be continuous play.

--- **No Gab** or **Cross Fade** track transition options are **OFF**.

### Mp3 Devices:

Install L-Book mp3 files to your mp3 devices the same way as you would a music album, just make sure play is set with shuffle off and cross fade off.

### Windows Media Player:

1. Just to the left of the search input window >> View Options set for Tile.
2. Window Layout shows the Navigation Pane left side under Library, Highlight Album.
3. The right side it states "Drag items here".
  - a. Open a Windows Explorer to the folder were the mp3 are located. Highlight all the tracks for the book. Drag them to the Media Player right side.
  - b. Or In the drop down menu "File", click "Open". Use the Brower to were the mp3 tracks are for the eBook. Highlight all tracks and click open.
4. Click "Album" on the left side. Icon of all the album covers. Scroll down until you see the eBook cover and double click and start the first track.
5. You can now click on the Burn Tab to burn to a CD, or click on the Sync Tab, drag the tracks to the right side and Sync to the connected device.

### iTunes:

1. Set View Display, left of Search Window is the Album View Button: pick the middle button or the right button.
2. Drop down menu in File, click the "Add Folder to Library". Browse to the audio fold of the audio eBook. Example: L-Book/Jae/ and highlight the Backwards folder and open.
3. You will see the new eBook cover in the Album list. Double click to start or sync to your mp3 device.

## How to Transfer or Copy Mobipocket eBook to a Kindle

When you buy eBooks from L-Book.com and other independent web book stores for your Kindle, you must buy or use the "Mobipocket" formatted version of the eBooks from these web stores. The Mobipocket formatted eBooks from these web stores are not DRM encoded protected. (Free of the DRM) Once you place the order on our web site, you will receive an email with the direct download link to the eBook. There will also be a red download button on you Invoice receipt, the last screen in the shopping cart. Save the eBook or L-Book to your computer and remember where you saved it. Which folder.

Go to the folder where you saved the download zip file. Double click the .zip file and extract the eBooks. Extract in your 'My Documents' folder for Windows XP and your 'User\Login\_Name' for Windows Vista & 7. Your eBooks are now located in the folder C:\My Documents\L-Book. Example Kindle :C:\My Documents\L-Book\Jae\Jae-Backwards\_mo.prc The \_mo.prc is the Kindle format type.

Once you get the eBook file onto your computer, you will need to transfer it to your Kindle. To do this, make sure the Kindle is powered off and use the USB cable that came with the device and plug it into the computer and the Kindle. Turn the Kindle on and wait until you see a new hard disk icon show up on your computer screen. This is your Kindle's hard drive (it may not have a name or it may have an odd name but it is the icon of the Kindle).

Open this removable drive icon (double click icon) and you will see some folders inside including one called "Documents". Go to where you saved the eBook you just purchased and drag the eBook file from your computer into the "Documents" folder on the new removable drive. I suggest you do a copy and not a move so you will always have a copy of your eBook or L-Book purchase on your computer. You can even backup your Kindle using this same method by copying (drag) from Kindle to your computer. Once you transferred the eBook to the Kindle, then you "eject" the removable drive (the icon should disappear). Once that's done, unplug the cable. You should now see the new eBook file in your Kindle directory.

The second way, but not recommended, you can transfer your DRM free, you can then email the eBook to your Kindle via your Amazon Kindle email account, including fanfiction from PDAFiction.com in the Mobipocket format. Amazon charges a small fee to use this service. Check Kindle's user guide on the exact procedures for this transfer method.

If you purchase a mobipocket (.prc) file you have two options for transferring your file to your Kindle using the provided USB cable or via wireless transfer.

Amazon now includes a dedicated PDF reader for the Kindle 2 and Kindle DX. Your Kindle can now display PDF documents without losing the formatting of the original file. Send PDF documents directly to your Kindle (via your @Kindle address) or drag and drop PDF files from your computer to your Kindle (when connected via USB). You can also magnify PDFs by viewing them in landscape mode.

If you prefer to have your personal PDF documents converted to the Kindle format so you can take advantage of Kindle functionality such as variable font size, annotation, Text-to-Speech, etc., type "Convert" in the subject of the e-mail when you submit your personal document to your @kindle.com address.
